Electronics this year are all by Linn and there is a fully **TigerPawed LP12** turntable with **Linn Urika II** providing the analogue input. But digitally :)

Besides the turntable, the Linn Klimax DSM is getting its music from an Innuos music server. The Linn Exaktbox digital crossover is in use and two Klimax Twin power amplifiers are providing the muscle.

We've had a little time with our demo **505**s and we really are taken with them.
